6.1 County Transportation Agency (CTA) Report (Diana Meehan)

Diana Meehan reported on the following items discussed at the September 26 CTA meeting:

- Doanh Nguyen was appointed as Caltrans District 4 Acting Chief
- SB1 Cycle 5 TCEP/SCCP, Round 1 NVTA submitted an intake form for the SR 29 through American Canyon Corridor Project
 - Active Transportation Workshops are underway stay tuned for dates.
- Sustainable Transportation Planning Grant Call for Applications released pick up a flyer for more details.

- The Caltrans District 4 Bay Area Transit Plan is now online. Caltrans is developing a transit needs assessment.
- The Metropolitan Transportation Commission provided an update on the Transit Priority Policy for Roadways and has a Transit Priority Assessment underway.
- The Plan Bay Area 2050+ draft will be released mid-October, with a comment period open through December.
- Cap and Invest (formerly Cap and Trade) is reauthorized through 2045, with changes to revenue distribution.
- AB 1085, prohibiting the sale/manufacture of license plate covers to avoid toll collection was passed and signed.
- SB707 which makes changes to the Brown Act that may ease virtual meeting requirements is on the governor's desk.
