SUBJECT: Nomination of Committee Member to the Napa Valley Vine Trail Coalition (NVVTC) Board of Directors

RECOMMENDATION

That the Active Transportation Advisory Committee (ATAC) nominate a member to represent the ATAC on the Napa Valley Vine Trail Coalition (NVVTC) Board of Directors.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Napa Valley Vine Trail Coalition (NVVTC) is a 501(c)3 not-for-profit organization, founded in 2008, with a vision “to build a walking/biking trail system that connects the entire Napa Valley physically, artistically, and culturally.” The NVVTC is “working to design, fund, construct, and maintain 47 safe and scenic miles of level, paved, family-friendly pet-friendly, free-access” Class I multi-use pathway from Calistoga to the Vallejo Ferry.

The NVVTC Board of Directors consists of more than 30 members, representing a wide array of community and civic interests. One seat has been identified as representing “Active Transportation Advisory Committees of Napa County.” The NVVTC has requested that the NVTA ATAC nominate a member who would fill that role, pending final approval by the NVVTC Board of Directors. Jonathan Schellin was nominated to this role in November 2023, but is stepping down due to scheduling conflicts.

The NVVTC Board meets the third Wednesday each month at 9:00 a.m. and currently holds hybrid (in-person and virtual) meetings.
