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SUBJECT: Approval of Resolution No. 17-05 for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2016-17

Low Carbon Transit Operations Program (LCTOP)

That the Napa Valley Transportation Authority (NVTA) Board approve Resolution No. 17-05 (Attachment 1) approving the Fiscal Year (FY) 2016-17 Low Carbon Transit Operations Program (LCTOP) project.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Napa Valley Transportation Authority (NVTA) is eligible under the Low Carbon Transit Operations Program (LCTOP) to receive formula funds totaling \$70,844 in FY 2016-2017. These funds are disbursed on a formula basis by both Caltrans and the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) and are generated from Assembly Bill 32 Cap & Trade proceeds. NVTA's application requests three years of LCTOP funds to purchase four Zero Emission Buses (ZEBs) to be used in the Town of Yountville, City of American Canyon and on Vine local routes.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Is there a fiscal impact? Yes

Is it currently budgeted? Yes

Where is it budgeted? It is currently budgeted in the bi-annual capital budget for replacement vehicles.

Future fiscal impact: These funds would be deferred to become revenue in a future fiscal year.

Consequences if not approved: NVTA would lose \$70,844 in FY 2016-17 LCTOP funding.

CEQA REQUIREMENTS

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The proposed action is not a project as defined by 14 California Code of Regulations 15378 (California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines) and therefore CEQA is not applicable.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

NVTA's application for LCTOP funds request would roll over funding for three fiscal years through FY 2018-19. By rolling over current fiscal year funds, NVTA estimates there will be approximately \$210,844 available in FY 2018-19. At that time, NVTA would purchase at least four Zero Emission Battery Electric Buses for use in the Town of Yountville, City of American Canyon and on Vine local routes. The total current estimated project cost is \$2,350,000. The remaining \$2,139,156 is expected to come from local Transportation Development Act (TDA) revenue, Transportation for Clean Air (TFCA) program, Federal Transportation Administration (FTA) 5339 funds, Air Resources Board (ARB) Hybrid and Zero-Emission Truck and Bus Voucher Incentive Project (HVIP), and other local funds.

A RESOLUTION OF THE NAPA VALLEY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE LOW CARBON TRANSIT OPERATIONS PROGRAM (LCTOP) PROJECT: VINE ZERO EMISSION BUS (ZEB) PROCUREMENT PROGRAM
