7.1 Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA) Fiscal Year End (FYE) 2019-2021 Program of Projects (Diana Meehan) (Pages 15-43)

#### Report by Diana Meehan.

- Reviewed the two applications received, both submitted by NVTA the Imola Park and Ride project and the Napa Valley Vine Trail Calistoga to St. Helena segment.

**7.2** Community Based Transportation Plan (CBTP) Process Timeline (Shaveta Sharma) (Pages 44-56)

- Reviewed the CBTP Scope of Work and Timeline.
- Identified Communities of Concern (COC) are the City of Calistoga (the city is one census tract), and three census tracts in the City of Napa. Ms. Sharma will send the COC census tract information to the TAC.
- Requested input from the TAC for the Scope of Work and Timeline.

#### Member Whan provided the following suggestions:

On the Scope of Work, third bullet, after "...and review with" add "local jurisdictions and" so that it reads:

"Gather existing, available information about Napa Valley transportation services, employment, schools, and neighborhoods, and review with the local jurisdictions and steering committee to identify data gaps and research questions." The City of Napa would like to identify any gaps prior to releasing the information to the public.

On the fourth bullet, at the end of the sentence, add "after having vetted them with local jurisdictions". So that it reads: "Establish what constitutes an eligible project and include specific projects in the plan after having vetted them with local jurisdictions."

Member Kirn echoed Member Whan's requests that the jurisdictions review the information before it is released to the public.

Ms. Schenck provided a presentation on the Comprehensive Operations Analysis (COA) Needs Assessment and invited comments from the TAC.
